Broccoli Salad

Ingredients

Salad

4 cups fresh, uncooked, chopped broccoli
1 cup chopped celery
¼ cup chopped green onions
½ cup raisins
8 slices streaky bacon, cooked crisp and crumbled
½ cup cashews, toasted
½ cup sunflower seeds, toasted

Dressing

½ cup mayonnaise
2 Tablespoons sugar
2 Tablespoons vinegar
2 Tablespoons milk
Pinch of salt

Combine first 4 salad ingredients and toss with dressing. Refrigerate for a couple of hours. Just before serving, add cashews, sunflower seeds and bacon.
