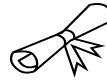

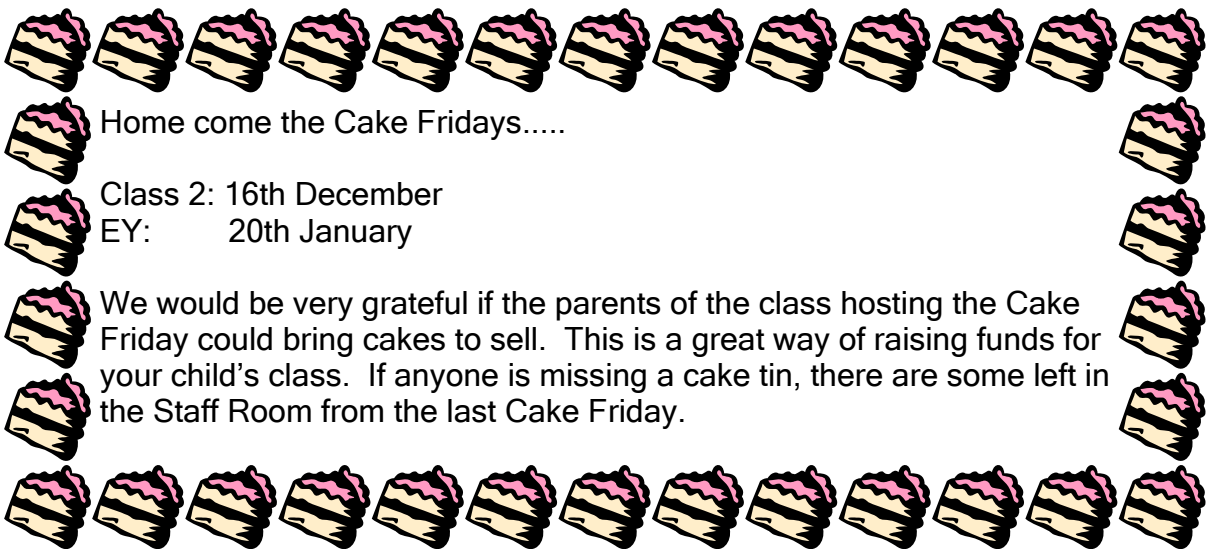
Friends of St. Teilo's
